## Hotel of the week: Hotel du Cap-Eden-Roc, Antibes, France

HOTEL DU CAP-EDEN-ROC REOPENS FOR ITS 151ST SEASON

As the global hospitality industry gets back on its feet, we'll be shining a light on hotels opening and reopening their doors around the Middle East and beyond, and the changes they've made to give guests peace of mind when returning.

**Reopening date:** June 4

### Location

A grand dame on the luxury hotel scene, Hotel du Cap-Eden-Roc oozes old school glamour, reopening this week for its 151st season. Set amongst perfectly manicured gardens on the French Riviera and gently lapped by the Mediterranean Sea, this storied hotel is the quintessential Riviera playground, with its own stretch of private shore, parkland, pool and pontoon.

### Rooms



Divided between three locations around Hotel du Cap, the hotel boasts 118 gorgeous guestrooms designed with French panache. Guests can expect to check-in to one of the guest rooms and suites located in the original Villa Soleil, the Eden-Roc Pavilion with the sea right below, or for a more private stay, Les Deux Fontaines residence, with its especially fresh and light interiors. The height of French Riviera luxury, the Eden-Roc Suite (pictured) sits proudly atop the Eden-Roc Pavilion, complete with a fabulous 200 square metre teak terrace – reminiscent of the deck of a yacht, complete with whirlpool bath and unrivalled views of the Lérins Islands and the Mediterranean Sea.

### **Food & Drink**





Newly re-envisioned menus across the hotels portfolio of restaurants and bars have been masterminded by Eric Frechon, of Oetker Collection sister hotel Le Bristol Paris' three Michelin starred Epicure and Hotel du Cap's executive chef, Arnaud Poette. Taking a contemporary approach to Mediterranean and Provençal cuisine that's echoed in the redesigned interiors, Eden-Roc Restaurant and Eden-Roc Grill reopened on June 4 alongside the hotel, while fine dining Louroc Restaurant, recently awarded a Michelin star, reopened on June 9. All are complimented by a collection of six bars; ranging from the refreshing juice and ice cream bar to the storied Eden Roc Champagne Lounge (pictured), located atop the Eden-Roc Pavilion, where an exclusive list of 14 Champagnes are paired with elegant hors d'œuvres.

## Leisure & Activities



The gorgeous grounds and serene sea are a postcard-perfect backdrop for sun-soaked days embracing the *joie de vivre* at this iconic property. Leisure activities on land include 33 cabanas that dot the rocky Mediterranean shoreline, offering blissful relaxation in total privacy, or take a dip in the saltwater infinity pool, carved straight out of the coastal cliff. Tennis courts, a pampering spa, fitness centre and salon cater to guests' every wellbeing need. On the endless azures of the sea, hop aboard the hotel's custom-made yacht for glamorous windblown trips to Saint-Tropez or Cannes. For families, the kids club will reopen on June 19.

### New Covid-19 related measures

The hotel has developed extensive new Covid-19 policies to protect guests and hoteliers. Temperature checks are mandatory for all, and all guest rooms now come with sanitisation kits and masks. Plexiglass screens have been installed at reception and concierge desks, and Hydroalcoholic gel distributors are positioned throughout the hotel. Staff will wear the required masks and gloves as necessary, and some spa services are off limits: the hammam and experience showers will remain closed, and the sauna will be available from July 1.

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
