The name was chosen by the rollers after hearing it read to them by the 'Lector' or 'reader', a tradition that is still maintained to this day. ## **SAN CRISTOBAL DE LA HABANA**

Launched in 1999, the original four sizes are named after the fortresses protecting the entrance to Havana's harbour. In 2004 an additional three sizes were introduced and these are named after well-known thoroughfares in Old Havana. They are of light-to-medium flavour.

## **JUAN LOPEZ**

In 1876, Juan López Sena (aka Juan López Diaz) created the Juan López brand. Producing cigars in Havana on Calle de los Dragones. In September 1960, the Cuban revolutionary government nationalized the Cuban cigar industry and seized the factory where Juan López cigars were manufactured. Production was resumed, and today all Juan López cigars are made by hand (totalmente a mano) at the La Habana factory in Havana.
