This oasis of calm, just steps away from the chic boutiques of the rue du Faubourg Saint-Honoré, only adds to the charm of this historic grande dame hotel, which has 190 elegant rooms. On mild spring evenings, I recommend dressing up and enjoying a glass of champagne in the courtyard before dinner in one of Le Bristol's two Michelin-starred restaurants, 114 Faubourg and Epicure.
