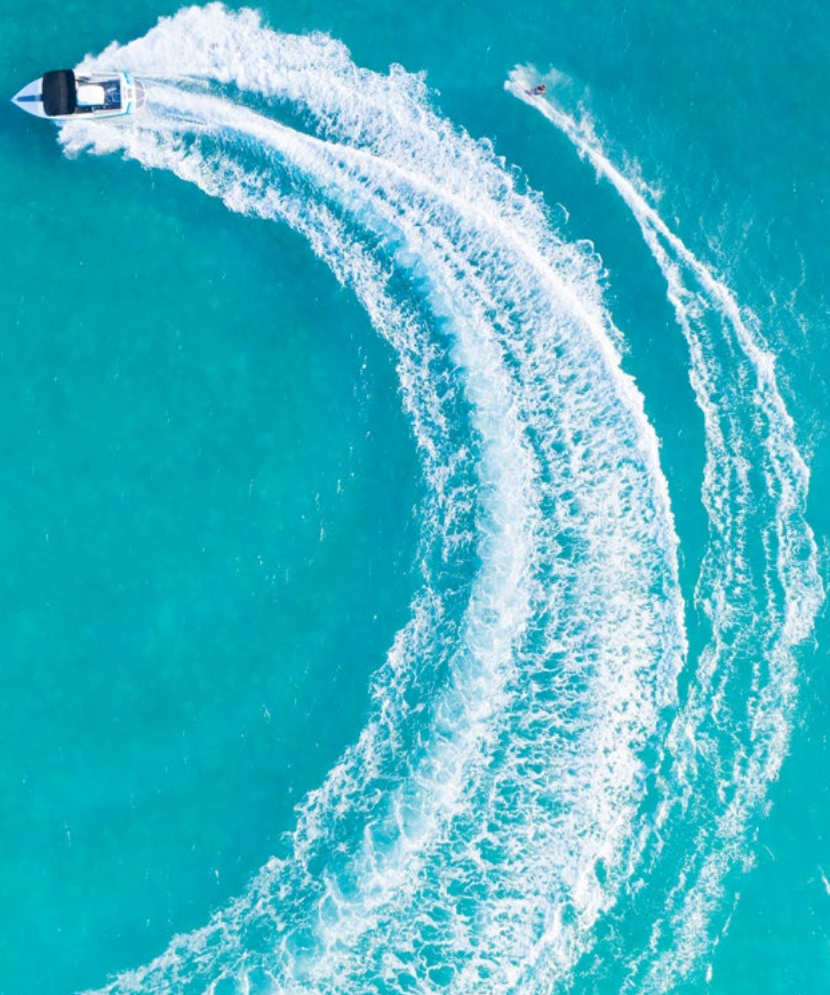

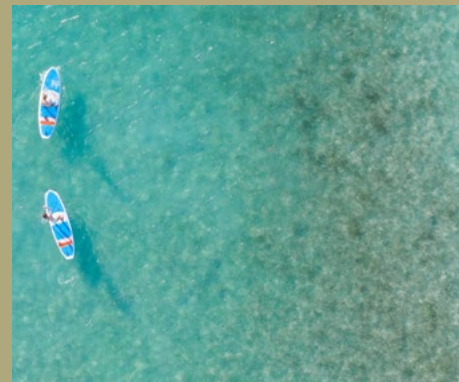
A breezy 45-minute tour along our private coastline, Jumby Bay Island is home to some of the most gorgeous beach villas and private residences.

Deep Sea Fishing Charters

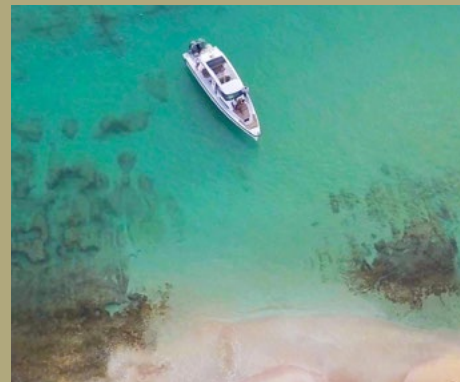
